

Hikoikoinga / Travel Arrangements

Flights

If possible please arrange flights in and out of Hamilton that fit with the Powhiri and Poroporoaki set times i.e. arrive by 12.30pm Wednesday, and depart no earlier than the 1.30 pm flight on Saturday.

Airport - city

Make your own way from Hamilton Airport to the gathering point at Te Wananga o Aotearoa Library, Glenview International Hotel. Fifteen minutes by taxi or shuttle.

City – Kawhia – airport

Buses will leave the Glenview International Hotel at 1.00 pm for Kawhia. Buses will leave the Marae on Saturday for the airport at 11.30am.

There will be security guarded parking available at the Glenview International Hotel for the duration of the Hui-a-Tau. Buses will be equipped with oral commentaries and will stop at historic sites on the way to Kawhia.
